
Disposable Masks

Each product will have

1 of 3 protection levels

FFP1

Low toxicity

- General dust
- Water based spray
- Paint mist (water based)

Particles larger than 5 microns

FFP2

Low to average toxicity

- Sanding of softwood
- Hand sanding MDF
- Ceramic tile dust
- Cutting slabs

Particles between 2 & 5 microns

FFP3

High toxicity

- Loft insulation
- Hardwood & MDF cutting
- Stone cutting
- Plastering

Particles less than 2 microns

Single Shift Use Only

These masks are for single shift use only To be disposed of after each period of work or 8 hour shift (max).

Best Dust Protection

These masks have passed the optional DOLOMITE clogging test, giving the user better breathing resistance for longer.
